Learning Objectives:

1. Describe how discrimination distress and exposure to racialized and state violence influence substance use risk, mental health outcomes and help-seeking behaviors among Black adolescents.
2. Examine how qualitative data from Black youth inform culturally responsive intervention design.
3. Discuss how culturally adapted treatments can address structural and relational barriers to substance use and mental health treatment for Black youth.
